Class One have a few exciting days planned over the next few weeks, including a 'Farm and Country' day and the BBC Ten Piece Primary Proms.

Classes One and Two have been invited to attend a 'Farm and Country' day at the Exhibition Halls, Royal Cornwall Showground on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> March. This is always a very popular educational event and so we are fortunate to have been allocated a place this year. The day will consist of numerous hands-on, interactive activities, learning how food travels from the farm to our plate. We will be leaving school at 8:30am and returning in time for the usual end of school routine.

As part of our Music curriculum, we have managed to secure tickets for Class One to watch a live performance of the BBCs Ten Piece Primary Proms the following day (Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> March) at the Hall for Cornwall, Truro. Cornwall Youth Orchestra will play a selection of pieces during the concert, which will provide the class with an inspiring introduction to classical music, as well as widen the children's musical knowledge, understanding and musical repertoire. We will be leaving school shortly after the register and be returning by 3:30pm.
