

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been given another amazing dance opportunity, this time at the Hall for Cornwall!

The Primary School Dance Platform will take place at The Hall for Cornwall on January 30th 2018 and is open to children from years 2-6.

It will comprise of primary schools, each performing their own dance to a paying audience.

The theme surrounding the festival will be 'Around the World in 80 Days' this will enable us to think about global issues and other cultures, fulfilling many cross curriculum topics as well as inspiring young people to perform.

The project will require quite a commitment from your child as well as yourself; they will have to attend weekly sessions (in school-time as well as 1 after school club) for 3 weeks. They will have to be passionate about dancing and willing to give it a go. ALL abilities will be more than welcome.

The actual event is an evening performance from 6 – 9pm. There is a charge to the audience (further details to follow.) We will be able to transport your child to the event as there is a rehearsal in the afternoon. However it will be your responsibility to collect your child from the theatre.

There will be a cost to yourself, for taking part in the project (this will cover transportation to the event as well as the cost of the project.) We will not be able to tell you exactly, until we know numbers, but envisage it to be in the region of £15.

There is a limit to the number of children that can take part so places will be allocated by the speed of response.
