Class One's Trip to Wildwood Escot, near Exeter Monday 4th March 2019

Dear Parent/Carer,

Class One's topics this term are 'What's So Wild About Canada' and 'The Smashing Saxons' (please find the curriculum advice leaflet on the website for further details). In order to bring learning to life and enrich the curriculum, I am organising a class trip to Wildwood Escot, which is between Exeter and Honiton on Monday 4th March 2019. The education package includes a series of hands-on activities based around the Anglo-Saxons in the morning, for instance making wattle and daub, bread making, foraging, milling, woodwork and making pennies. After lunch, we will enjoy a foraging walk, which will take us through the animal collection, where the highlight will be the opportunity to learn about the wolf pack.
