- 8:15am start £2.50
- 8:30am start £1.50
- After School Club provision operates Mon Thur from 3:30pm 4:30pm (5pm for Film Club on a Wednesday) and costs £2.50 per child per session (£3 per session for Film Club). Again, bookable and payable on School Money.

Please send your child to school in a winter PE kit – joggers/tracksuit bottoms/PE top/school jumper/trainers.
