## **Parental Advice Leaflet**

- 1. Get to know the services and web sites your child uses. If you don't know how to use them, get your child to show you.
- 2. Set reasonable rules and guidelines for computer use by your children and discuss these rules and post them near the computer as a reminder. Remember to monitor their compliance with these rules, especially when it comes to the amount of time they spend on the computer.
- 3. Do not overreact if your child tells you about a problem he or she is having on the Internet. Instead, work together to try to solve the problem and prevent it from happening again.
- 4. Do not to use a computer or the Internet as an electronic babysitter!
- 5. Make the Internet a family activity and ask your child to help plan family events using the Internet.
