Class 2 Residential Trip Wednesday 6th June - Thursday 7th June

Dear Parents/Carers,

A trip to Lanhydrock followed by an overnight stay at Boscastle Youth Hostel and then a trip to the Cornwall at War Museum has been arranged for children in class 2. This is an opportunity for the children to enjoy and experience a short overnight stay with their friends which is not too far from home.

The itinerary will be as follows;

Wednesday 6th June 2018

- 9am - Parents drop children at school with their belongings.
- 9.30am - The coach to Lanhydrock leaves school.
- 10am - arrive at Lanhydrock
- 12.30-1.15- Lunch time - **(Children bring a packed lunch or order a school packed lunch)**
- 4pm, coach leaves Lanhydrock and travels to Boscastle. Children walk from the car park to Boscastle Youth Hostel
- 5pm- sort out rooms, fish and chip supper, followed by games and a story
- Bed by 8pm.

Thursday 7th June 2018

- 7.30-8am Breakfast,
- 10.30am Coach leaves Boscastle car Park
- 10.45am Arrive at the Cornwall At War Museum, Davidstow.
- 12.30-1.15pm Picnic lunch **(please complete the form attached)**
- 3pm- Parents to collect children from the Museum.

Boscastle Youth Hostel

Boscastle Youth Hostel is like a home from home in a fabulous location. The children will be able to share a room with a few friends and will be supervised by a member of staff for added security. Please note; we will have sole occupancy of the hostel for our overnight stay.

Food Provisions

Children need to have a packed lunch for the first day. If you wish to order your child a school packed lunch use the form attached dated 6/6/18.

Children will be able to order their fish and chip supper nearer the time. This is provided by the fish and chip shop in Boscastle.



For breakfast, there will be a choice of cereals, toast, fruit along with milk, water or juice.
On the second day, all children need to order a school packed lunch so please complete the form attached dated 7/6/18.

A kit list is attached to this letter so that you know what your child/children will need.

The total cost of the residential will be £45 per pupil. This includes the cost of the hostel and the coach, as well as the fish and chip supper, breakfast and lunch for the Thursday.
If your child is in receipt of pupil premium funding, the cost of the residential is £35.
