Dear Parents

We have booked to take the whole school to Camel Creek on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July, the penultimate day! All of our fingers and toes are crossed in the hope that Covid doesn't prevent some or all of the children / staff being able to enjoy this experience.

We shall be leaving school at approximately 9.10 am and returning for 3.15 pm. Your child will need to be wearing lightweight trousers/leggings and a long sleeved top. There are many slides at Camel Creek which require such clothing and this will also double up as sun protection, should we be lucky enough to need it.

A small rucksack containing a water bottle, packed lunch, snack and lightweight waterproof coat will also be required. Should you wish to order a packed lunch from the school kitchen, please do so by Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July at the latest using AspensSELECT. Don't forget, this is free for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. It is also free if you are in receipt of Free School Meals for your child.

If you would like your child to bring along some spending money, staff are happy to supervise the purchase of ice cream and/or small souvenir. Children in Class 2 and 3 should bring their money in a named envelope which their group leader will look after until the point of spending. Children in Class 1 will be responsible for their own money. We suggest that £3 - £5 would be plenty.

The cost of transportation has kindly been paid for by The Friends, using a fraction of the money raised from the sponsored walk. The cost of admission for a school child is £4.50. Please pay for your child to attend the trip using school money and thereby giving your permission by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July.
