ALL CLUBS COST £1 EACH PER CHILD PER WEEK - These charges will endeavour to cover the cost of staffing and resourcing across the range of clubs. Please book and pay by Friday, 1st March 2019 via www.schoolmoney.co.uk and provide consent for your child to attend. If payment and consent is not received, please collect your child promptly at 3.30 pm.

After school clubs are provided so that children can acquire and develop new skills in addition to those gained during normal curriculum time. Please note that clubs are not a childcare facility; your child should want to be there to learn.

We are extremely grateful to all of the adults who run a club after school and expect excellent behaviour from all of the children who attend. If your child does display undesirable behaviour they shall miss the following week's club. You shall of course be informed of this privately.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE: From time to time clubs do need to be cancelled due to inclement weather or staff training/ illness. If this is the case you will be notified by text / phone. Please then make arrangements for your child to be collected at 3.30 pm.
