Literacy

Grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS):

For the weeks leading up to the Y6 SATs, there will be a greater focus on revising GPS skills. **Non-fiction:** The class will create professional-looking informative leaflet about a region of the UK, focusing on famous landmarks (travel brochure) found there. **Fiction/ Drama:** Miss Forbes will be producing our Summer play, entitled (more details to follow). **Poetry:** We will enjoy reading and reciting some favourite poems, focusing on performance techniques,

e.g. clarity, using intonation and varied pace.

Geography

This term will involve a lot of map work, focusing on counties in the UK, cities, rivers and famous landmarks. We will also look at changes that have occurred over a period of time.

<u>Science</u>

- We will be celebrating Science week from May 20th – 24th. This will be based around a whole school trip to the beach, e.g. living things and their habitats, materials and environmental impact.

- States of matter, which will include changing states by heating and cooling, plus the water cycle (condensation and evaporation).

PE – every Tuesday and Thursday

- Cricket/ rounders – as well as playing games, we will also be focusing on improving our technique.

- Athletics, in preparation for sports day later this term.

Mathematics

Y6 SATs revision.

Fractions, decimals and percentages – Identify fractions to decimal and percentage equivalents. **Multiplication and division –** Revise facts to 12x12 and revisit informal and formal written methods for multiplying and dividing larger numbers.

Measurement – Calculate the perimeter and area of shapes and convert measures, e.g. mm to cm. Calculate and compare the volume of cubes and cuboids.

Time – Read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 12- and 24-hour clocks. Solve time problems.

Position and direction – Describe positions on a coordinates grid and plot specified points; identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation.

French

This term's topics include: my daily routine, telling the time, ordering food & drink. As well as acquiring new vocabulary, the children will be encouraged to build upon known words and phrases it to produce longer, more complex sentences, both orally and in writing.
