As well as the Home Learning Pack, Class One children have been give the following:

- Y3/4 Statutory Spelling List
- Y5/6 Statutory Spelling List
- A weekly spelling overview of each of the spelling rules we would be covering over the Summer term and ten spellings which follow each particular rule
- Weekly Grammar Workouts for the remainder of the Spring term and the first half of the Summer Term (with an answer sheet)
- Mental Arithmetic weekly workouts for the first half of the Summer term (with an answer sheet)

Please encourage daily reading – many children have chosen books from our Reading Corner to take home with them for the duration of the school closure. Please ask them questions to check they are reading and understanding the text accurately.

Please keep the times tables ticking over. The children have worked really hard on our weekly challenge so it would be great for their speed of recall to continue to improve.
