## Important Home Learning Updates For Class Three Children

Dear parents,
Thank you for your ongoing support. It has been great to receive the children's completed work and we have been grateful of the positive feedback from some parents and children so far - it is of course a learning curve for us too!

We have tried to ease you and your child(ren) into Google Classroom gently, as we are aware it is a new means of learning. From now on, all children in Class Three will receive one Maths and one Literacy session each day. The Maths will go live each day at approximately 8 am and the Literacy at 10 am , although of course, this can be completed at a time that suits you and your family that day.

## 'Google Meet' video chat

As of Monday $11^{\text {th }}$ January, we will be introducing a video chat with the class teacher and members of their year group (Classes Two and Three have already got this up and running). This will enable everyone to touch base, discuss school work and as of Monday $18^{\text {th }}$ January, be part of a daily phonics session. It is important that your child joins this call.

To access the video chat, go to Google Classroom at the set time (see below) and in the 'Stream'/ home page, you will see a link for 'Google Meet'. There are no additional passwords needed. If you are on a tablet, it is best to download the 'Google Meet' App first. We will use Monday's meet as a trial run! Please note that each year group will have a set time for their video call:

Children in Years One and Two will also have the option to join a short second call in the afternoon to review their learning. We understand if you are unable to do so, e.g. if you need an afternoon walk!
