The bus will be leaving at 8.55 am and will return to school at approximately 3.15 pm so should not interfere with the normal school day.

The children will need to wear school uniform on top. The event will be held indoors within large exhibition halls but they can be cold and draughty, so please ensure your child is dressed appropriately to keep them warm and ensure that your child brings a coat. Children should also wear appropriate footwear; we would suggest wellies or sturdy shoes/boots.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch and sufficient drink to last them for the day. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and requires a school packed lunch, please book via AspensSELECT by Friday, 17th March so arrangements can be made. Children are not asked to bring any spending money as there will be no opportunities to spend it.

There is no charge for this trip, as the event is organised and funded by the organisers, the Royal Cornwall Agricultural Association and Cornwall Food & Farming Group. However, we are asking for a £6 contribution towards transport. Please pay via School Money. If we are in receipt of Pupil Premium for your child and you need financial support, please do not hesitate to get in touch.
