Dear Parents/ Carers

I have already started to think ahead to next year's residential trip, which is a highlight in the school calendar for many children. It is also a fantastic opportunity to build self-confidence, self-esteem and resilience, as well as promoting team building skills and gaining other important life skills.

This academic year, I am planning to take Year 5/6 away to PGL Barton Hall, Torquay for three days/ two nights from the 22nd to 24th June 2020, please check out their website <https://www.pgl.co.uk/en-gb/school-trips/primary-schools/centres/barton-hall>.

During our time there, we will carry out numerous outdoor adventure activities such as rifle shooting, using the climbing wall, quad biking, high ropes course, team building skills and possibly water sports – this is of course yet to be decided and confirmed, and will be discussed with the children at a later date. The all inclusive price for this trip will be approximately £180.00 to include coach transportation to and from Barton Hall. If the school is in receipt of Pupil Premium for your child, we are able to offer a £30.00 reduction in cost.

The Year 5/6 children from St Breward, St Teath and Camelford Primaries will also be attending at the same time with evening activities planned to aid Year 6 transition to Secondary School.
